### TAXING TIME FOR MILLIONS

If you are one of the three million people who have just received a bill from the taxman, make sure you pay it on time.

This is the second instalment of tax owed on money earned in the last tax year which ended in April.

You will have been billed by the Inland Revenue if you are self-employed, have savings or if you do some freelance work that brings you extra income.

If you have, make sure you pay it by July 31-if you don't you will be charged daily interest at 6.5 per cent.

If you have not yet completed your tax return for last year, the bill will be estimated on your previous year's earnings. If your income has gone down you can make a claim for a reduction by completing a SA302 form.

Make sure you don't underestimate as you will be charged interest if it turns out you have underpaid.

Whether you've been billed or not, if you've been sent a tax return, get it in by September 30 and the taxman will calculate your bill for you.
